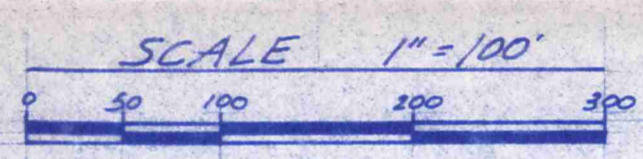
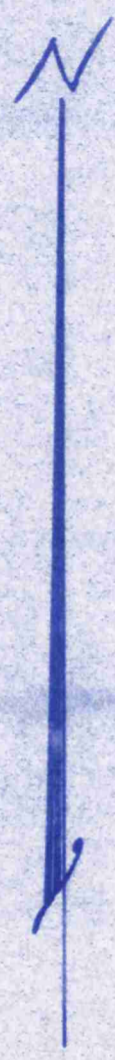


MAP OF A SURVEY FOR

Situated in the Township of Burton, County of Geauga and State of Ohio being part of Original Lot No. 18 within said township and further described as follows:

Beginning in the centerline of Hale Road at the southeast corner of land conveyed to D. C. and D. E. Klingman by deed recorded in Vol. 1092, Page 801 of the Geauga County Records of Deeds;

Thence South 00 Deg. 23' 42" West along the centerline of Hale Road a distance of 123.00 feet to a point;

Thence South 89 Deg. 58' 11" West, passing through an iron pin set at 30.00 feet, a distance of 1820.35 feet to an iron pin set in an east line of land conveyed to J. Miller, et al., by deed recorded in Vol. 838, Page 900 of the Geauga County Records of Deeds;

Thence North 00 Deg. 01' 26" West along the east line of the said Miller land a distance of 123.00 feet to an iron pin found in the south line of the aforementioned Klingman land;

Thence North 89 Deg. 58' 11" East along the south line of the said Klingman land a distance of 1821.25 feet to the place of beginning, passing through an iron pin set 40.00 feet therefrom, containing within said bounds 5.142 acres of land according to the survey of Forest Land Design, Inc., by J. Arthur Temple, Ohio Registered Surveyor No. 4761 dated November, 1997.
