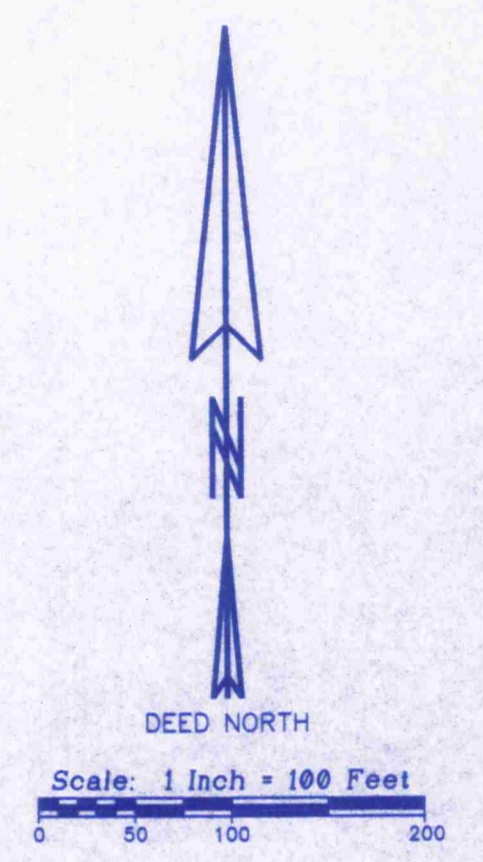
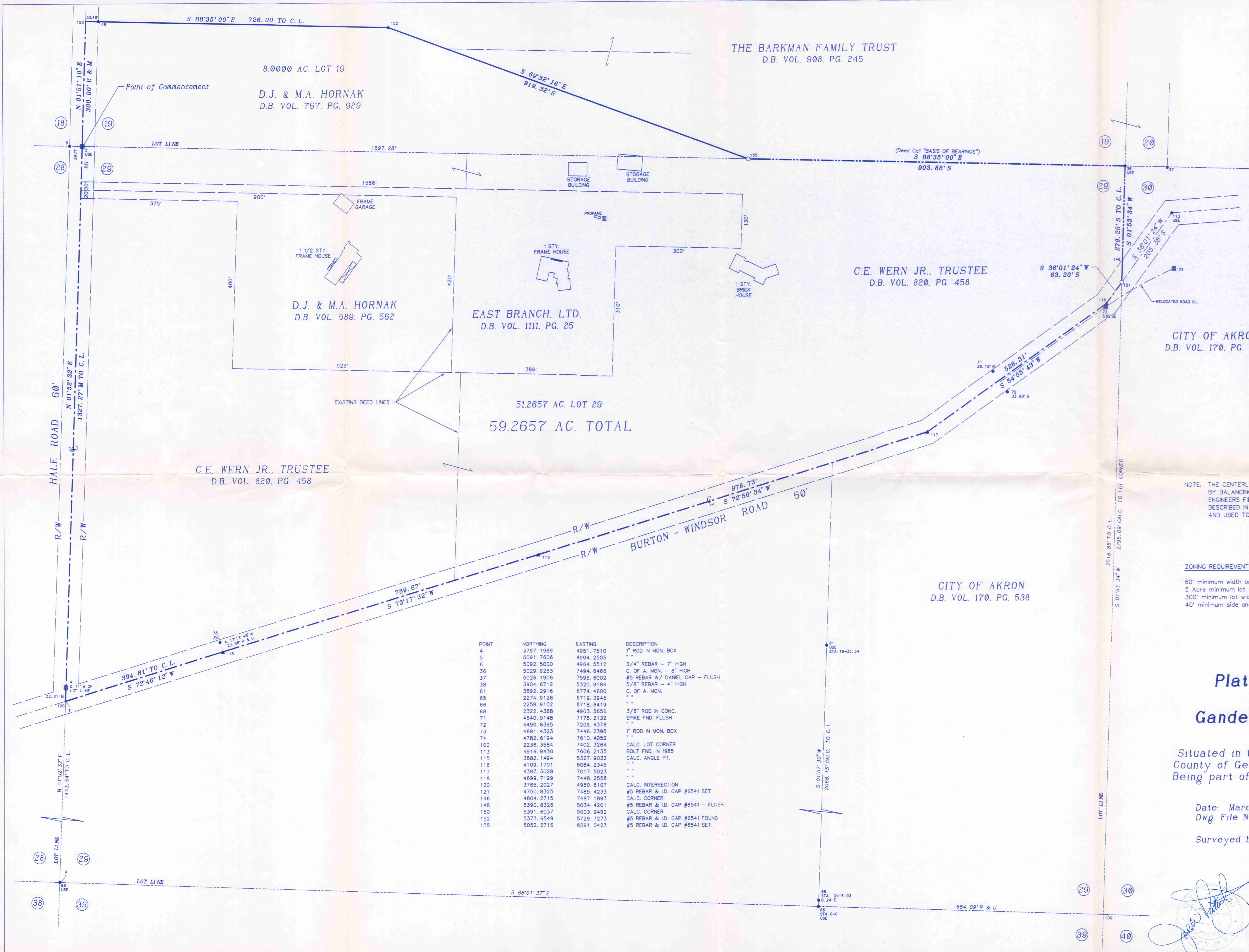

NOTE: THE CENTERLINE OF BURTON - WINDSOR ROAD WAS ESTABLISHED BY BALANCING THE ANGLES AND DISTANCES NOTED IN COUNTY ENGINEER'S FIELD NOTES. MONUMENTS NO. 38 AND 113 WERE DESCRIBED IN THE FIELD NOTES AND LOCATED IN NOVEMBER 1985 AND USED TO ESTABLISH THE CENTERLINE.

Situated in the Township of Burton, County of Geauga and State of Ohio: known as being part of Great Lots No. 19 & 29, further bounded and described as follows;

**COMMENCING** at a 1" rod found in a monument box at the northwest corner of Great Lot No. 29 and in the centerline of Hale Road, 60 feet wide;


- Course 1: thence North 01 deg. 51 min. 10 sec. East, along the centerline of Hale Road and the west line of Great Lot No. 19, a distance of 300.00 feet to a point (witness a #5 rebar and I.D. cap #6541 found flush, South 88 deg. 35 min. 00 sec. East, a distance of 30.48 feet from point described);
- Course 2: thence South 88 deg. 35 min. 00 sec. East, along the south line of land conveyed to The Barkman Family Trust, by instrument recorded in D.B. Vol. 908, Pg. 245 Geauga County Records, a distance of 726.00 feet to a #5 rebar and I.D. cap #6541 found flush this survey;
- Course 3: thence South 69 deg. 32 min. 16 sec. East, continuing along a south line of land conveyed to The Barkman Family Trust, a distance of 919.32 feet to a #5 rebar and I.D. cap #6541 set 1" high this survey in the south line of Great Lot No. 19;
- Course 4: thence South 88 deg. 35 min. 00 sec. East, along the north line of Great Lot No. 29, a distance of 903.88 feet to a City of Akron monument found 8" high at the northeast corner of Great Lot No. 29;
- Course 5: thence South 01 deg. 53 min. 34 sec. West, along the east line of Great Lot No. 29, a distance of 279.25 feet to a #5 rebar and I.D. cap #6541 set flush this survey on the former centerline of Burton - Windsor Road, 60 feet wide (witness a bolt found in Nov. 1985 at an angle point, North 36 deg. 01 min. 24 sec. East, a distance of 205.38 feet from rebar set);
- Course 6: thence South 36 deg. 01 min. 24 sec. West, along the centerline of Burton - Windsor Road, a distance of 63.20 feet to an angle point;
- Course 7: thence South 54 deg. 55 min. 43 sec. West, continuing along the centerline of Burton - Windsor Road, a distance of 526.31 feet to an angle point;
- Course 8: thence South 72 deg. 50 min. 34 sec. West, continuing along the centerline of Burton - Windsor Road, a distance of 976.73 feet to an angle point;
- Course 9: thence South 73 deg. 17 min. 32 sec. West, continuing along the centerline of Burton - Windsor Road, a distance of 789.67 feet to an angle point (witness a 5/8" rebar found 4" high, North 17 deg. 13 min. 48 sec. West, a distance of 23.58 feet from point described);
- Course 10: thence South 72 deg. 46 min. 12 sec. West, continuing along the centerline of Burton - Windsor Road, a distance of 394.81 feet to a point and the centerline intersection of Burton - Windsor Road and Hale Road (witness a 3/8" rod in concrete found at the southwest corner of Great Lot No. 29, South 01 deg. 52 min. 32 sec. West, a distance of 1443.54 feet from the centerline intersection point described);

Course 11: thence North 01 deg. 52 min. 32 sec. East, along the centerline of Hale Road and the west line of Great Lot No. 29, a distance of 1327.27 feet to the **PLACE OF COMMENCEMENT** and containing 59.2657 acres of land of which 8.0000 acres is in Great Lot No. 19 and 51.2657 acres is in Great Lot No. 29, but subject to all legal highways, rights and easements of record, as surveyed in March 2002 by John W. Patrick Jr. P.S. #6541.

The bearing of South 88 deg. 35 min. 00 sec. East, along the north line of Great Lot No. 29 as described in D.B. Vol. 552, Pg. 824 Geauga County Records, was used for the "BASIS OF BEARINGS" for this legal description.
