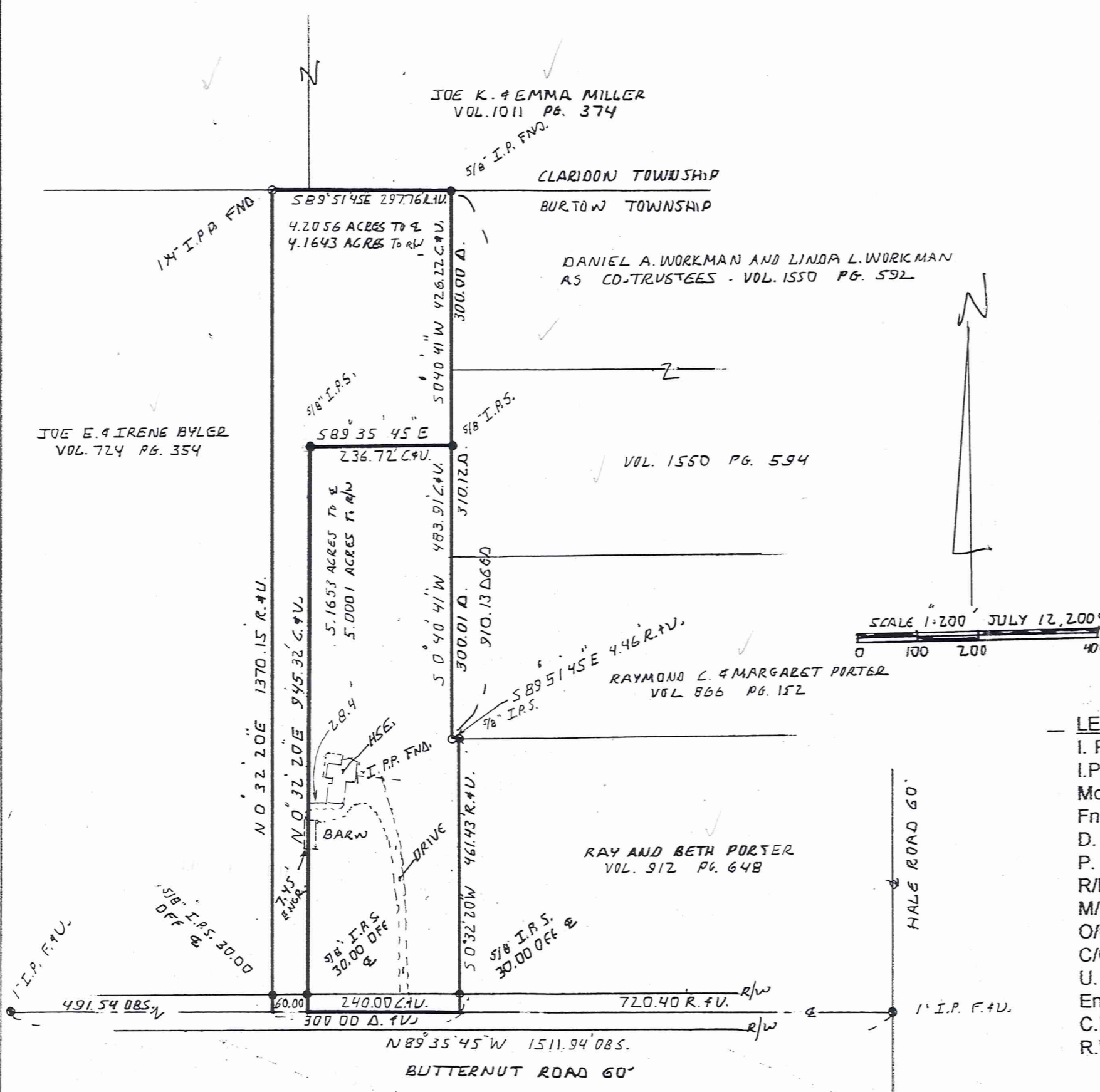

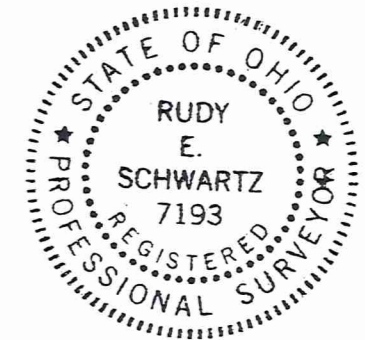

Szorady Jr. and Nance J. Szorady by deed recorded in Volume 841, Page 500 of Geauga County Deed Records, further bounded and described as follows;

Beginning at a point in the centerline of Butternut Road, 60 feet wide, at the Southwesterly corner of land conveyed to Ray and Beth Porter by deed recorded in Volume 912, Page 648 of Geauga County Deed Records, said point lying North 89°35'45" West along said centerline of Butternut Road, a distance of 720.40 feet from a one inch iron pin found at its intersection with the centerline of Hale Road, 60 feet wide;

Thence North 89°35'45" West along said centerline of Butternut Road, a distance of 240.00 feet to a point and the principle place of beginning of the premises herein intended to be described;

COURSE I Thence continuing North 89°35'45" West along said centerline of Butternut Road, a distance of 60.00 feet to the Southeasterly corner of land conveyed to Joe E. and Irene Byler by deed recorded in Volume 724, Page 354 of Geauga County Deed Records;

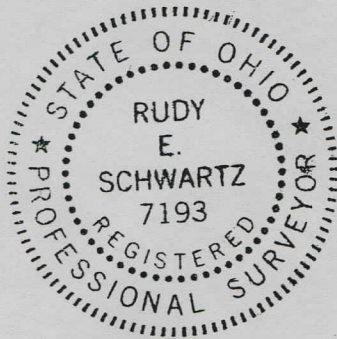

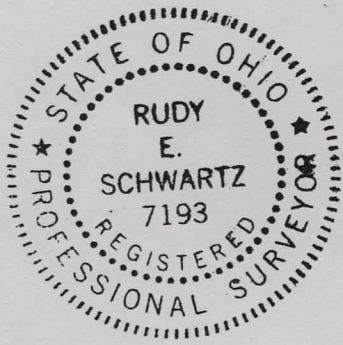
