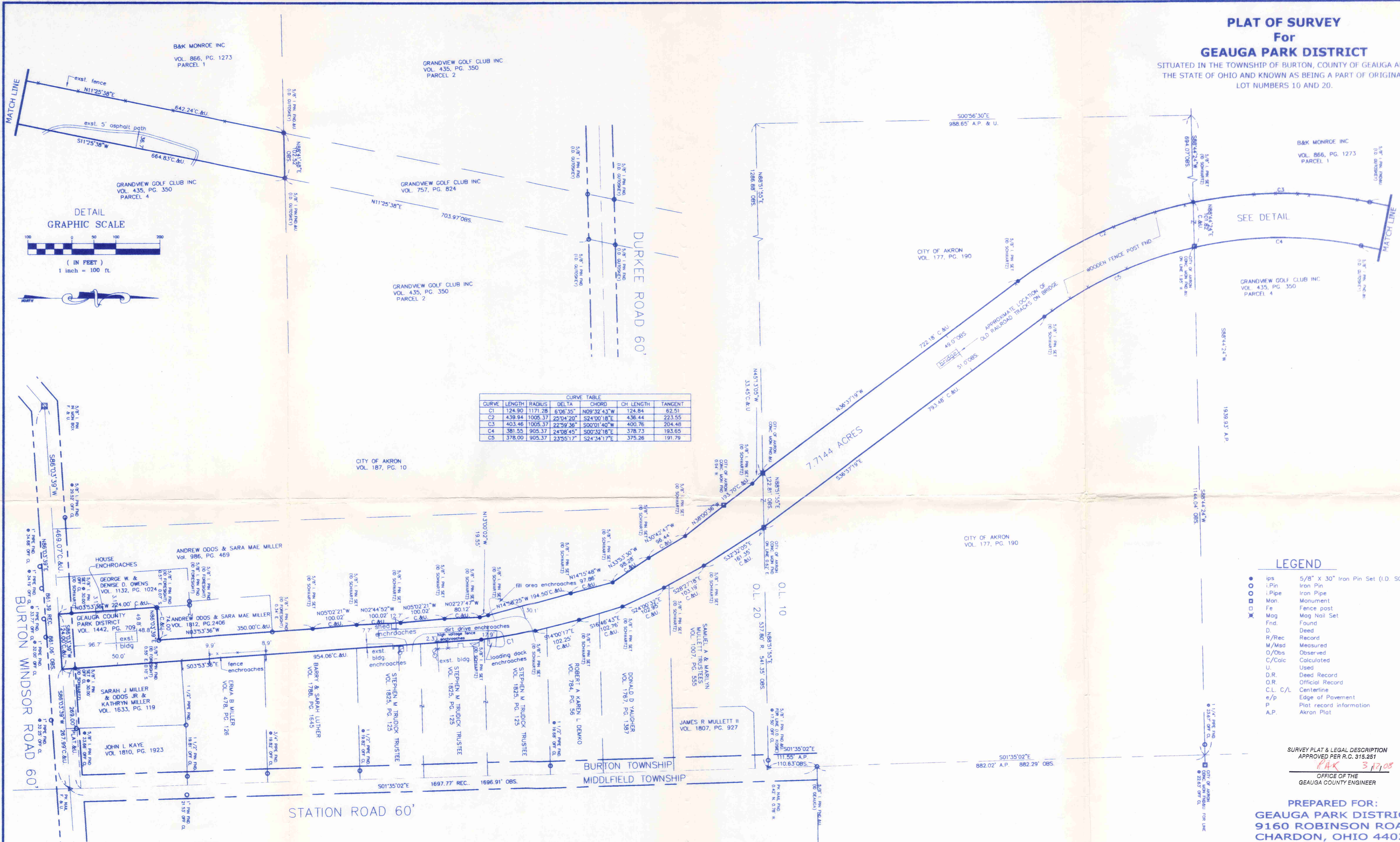
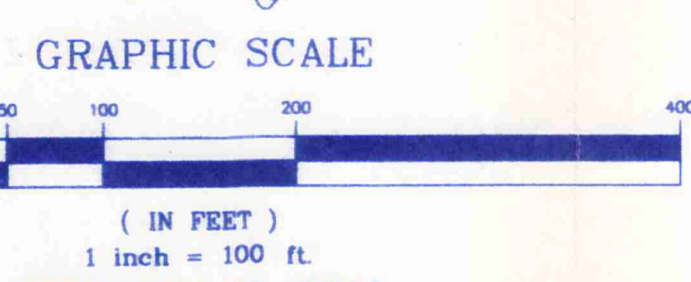
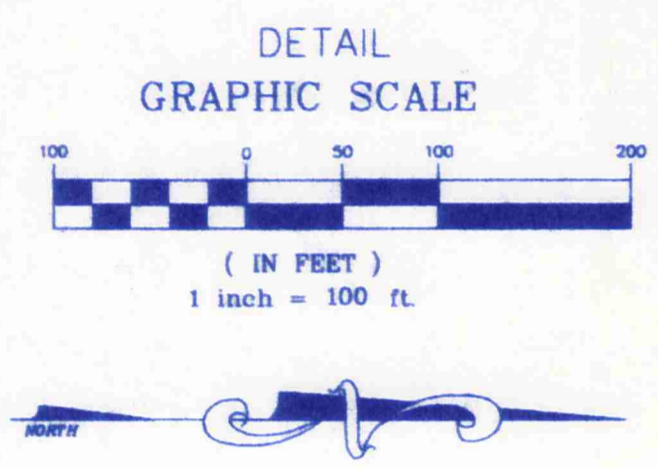


PLAT OF SURVEY For GEAUGA PARK DISTRICT

Situated in the Township of Burton, County of Geauga, and State of Ohio and known as being a part of Original Lot No.s 10 and 20, and further being known part of a parcel of lands conveyed to Geauga Park District (PPN 18-018200) by deeds recorded in Volume 1442, Page 709 of Geauga County Deed Records, further bounded and described as follows;

Beginning at a P.K. nail found, on the Easterly line of Burton Township, in the centerline of Burton-Windsor Road, 60 feet wide, at its intersection with the centerline of Station Road, 60 feet wide, said P.K. nail lying North $86^{\circ} 03' 39''$ East, along said centerline of Burton-Windsor Road, a distance of 861.06 feet from a monument box found with a $5/8$ inch iron pin found at an angle point therein;

Thence South $86^{\circ} 03' 39''$ West, along said centerline of Burton-Windsor Road, a distance of 267.99 feet to the Southwesterly corner of land conveyed to Sarah J. Miller and Odos Jr. and Kathryn Miller by deed recorded in Volume 1633, Page 119 of Geauga County Deed Records, and the Principal Place of Beginning herein intended to be described;

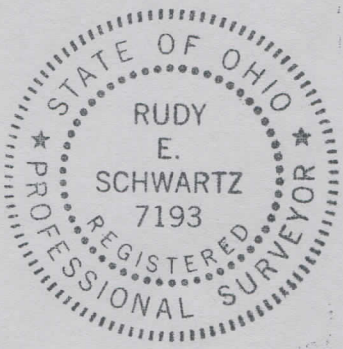
