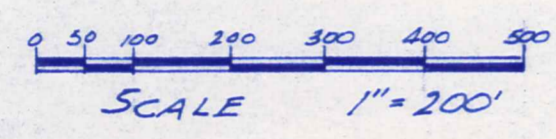
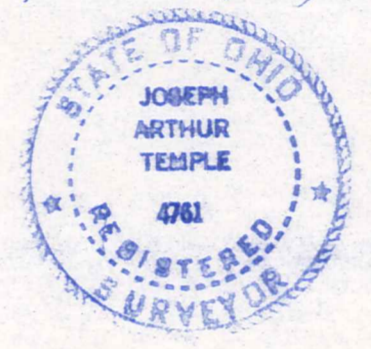


MAP OF A SURVEY FOR

HAMB DEN TOWNSHIP — GEauga COUNTY — OHIO



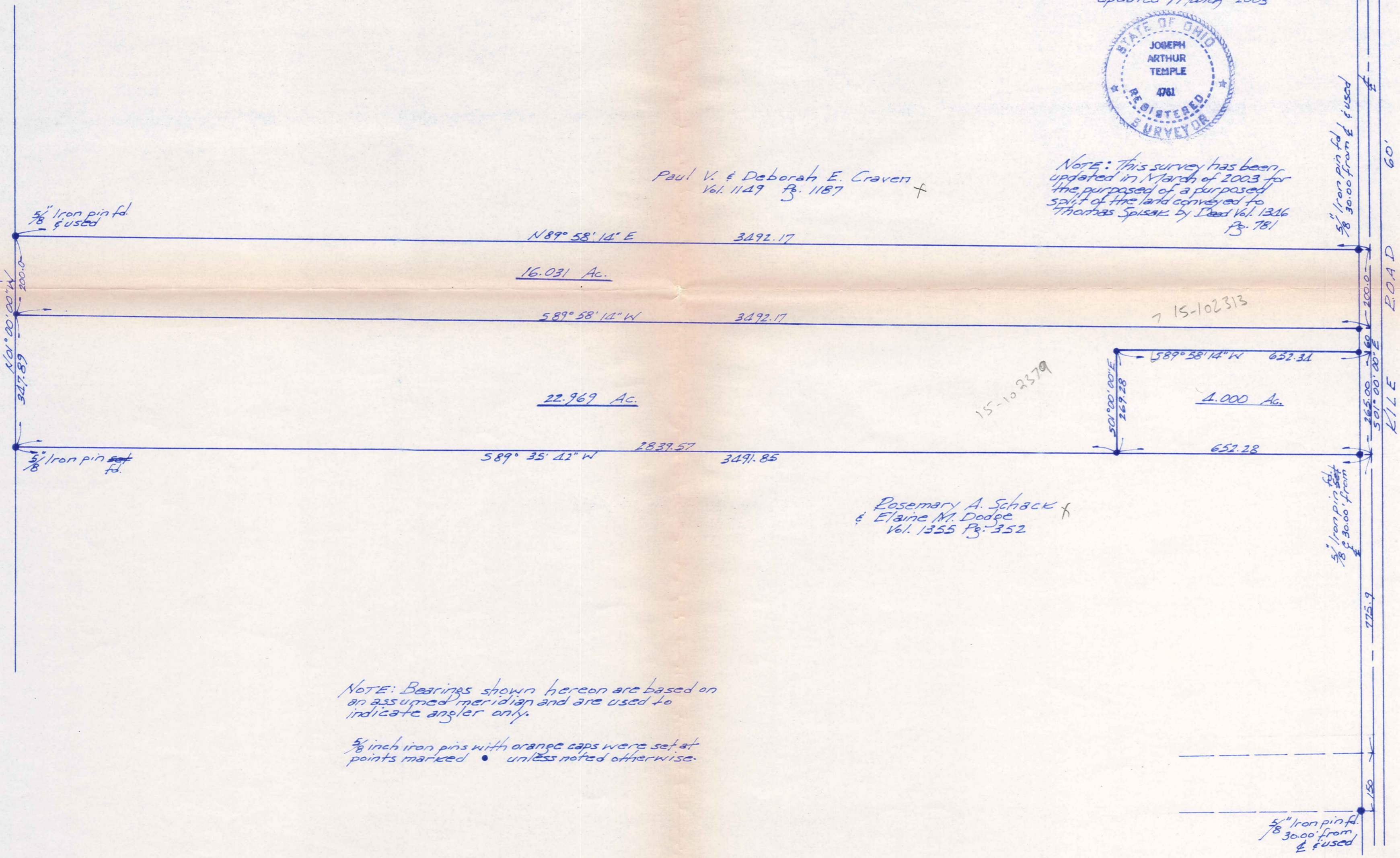

Thence South 01° 00' 00" East along the centerline of Kile Road a distance of 200.00 feet to a point;

Thence South 89° 58' 14" West, passing thru a 5/8 inch iron pin set at 30.00 feet, a distance of 3492.17 feet to a 5/8 inch iron pin set in the east line of land conveyed to the State of Ohio by deed recorded in Vol. 226, Pg. 581 of the Geauga County Records of Deeds;

Thence North 01° 00' 00" West along the east line of the said State of Ohio land and along the east line of a second parcel conveyed to the State of Ohio by deed recorded in Vol. 427, Pg. 993 of the Geauga County Records of Deeds, a total distance of 200.00 feet to a 5/8 inch iron pin found at the southwest corner of the aforementioned Craven land;

Thence North 89° 58' 14" East along the south line of the said Craven land a distance of 3492.17 feet to the place of beginning, passing thru a 5/8 inch iron pin found 30.00 feet therefrom, containing within said bounds 16.031 acres of land, according to the survey of J. 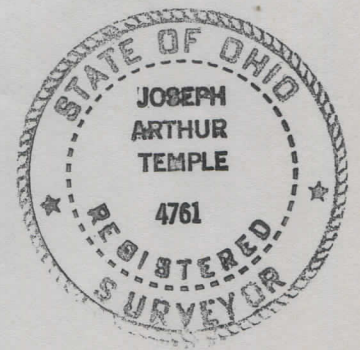

Beginning in the centerline of Kile Road at a point which is South 01° 00' 00" East along said road centerline a distance of 200.00 feet from the southeast corner of land conveyed to Paul V. and Deborah E. Craven by deed recorded in Vol. 1149, Pg. 1187 of the Geauga County Records of Deeds;

Thence South 01° 00' 00" East along the centerline of Kile Road a distance of 60.00 feet to a point;

Thence South 89° 58' 14" West, passing thru a 5/8 inch iron pin set at 30.00 feet, a distance of 652.34 feet to a 5/8 inch iron pin set;

Thence South 01° 00' 00" East a distance of 269.28 feet to a 5/8 inch iron pin set in the north line of land conveyed to Rosemary A. Schack and Elaine M. Dodge by deed recorded in Vol. 1355, Pg. 352 of the Geauga County Records of Deeds;

Thence South 89° 35' 42" West along the north line of the said Schack/Dodge land a distance of 2839.57 feet to a 5/8 inch iron pin found in the east line of land conveyed to the State of Ohio by deed recorded in Vol. 226, Pg. 581 of the Geauga County Records of Deeds;

Thence North 01° 00' 00" West along the east line of the said State of Ohio land a distance of 347.89 feet to a 5/8 inch iron pin set;

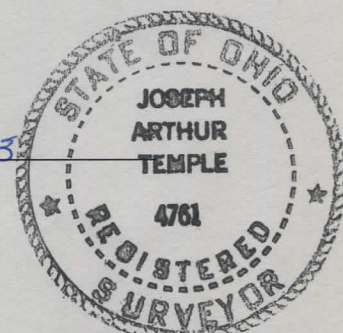
