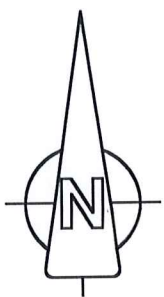

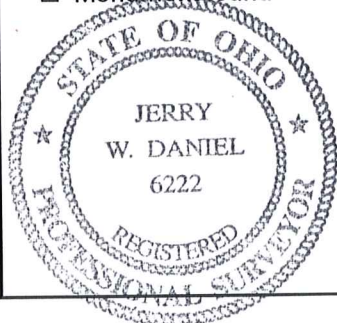

Parcel One

Situated in the Township of Huntsburg, County of Geauga, and State of Ohio, and known as being part of Lot 5 in said township, and further bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of Madison Road at the southeast corner of land conveyed to D. and I. Burkholder by deed recorded in Volume 985 - Page 185 of Geauga County Record of Deeds, said point being South 1° 00' West, a distance of 564.15 feet from the northeast corner of said Lot 5;

thence South 1° 00' West, along said centerline of Madison Road, a distance of 313.85 feet to a point;

thence North 87° 41' West, and passing over a 5/8" rebar iron pin set at 65.02 feet, a distance of 483.89 feet to a 5/8" rebar iron pin set;

thence North 1° 00' East, a distance of 309.36 feet to a 5/8" rebar iron pin found at the southwest corner of said Burkholder's land;

thence South 88° 12' 52" East along the south line of said Burkholder's land, and passing over a 5/8" rebar iron pin found at 418.81 feet, a distance of 483.81 feet to a point and the true place of beginning and containing therein 3.4606 acres of land as surveyed in April, 1997 by Jerry W. Daniel, Registered Surveyor No. 6222.
