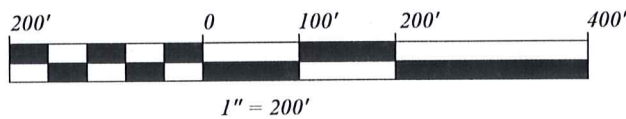


**Graphic Scale**

Description of Land  
for  
T.A.P. Partnership

Situated in the Township of Troy, County of Geauga, and State of Ohio, and known as being part of Section 8 in said Township, and further bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of Nash Road at the southeast corner of land conveyed to J. and E. Schmucker by deed recorded in Volume 769, Page 1070 of Geauga County Record of Deeds, said point being South 90° 00' West, a distance of 1173.44 feet from the centerline intersection of said Nash Road and Jug Street;

thence North 0° 48' East, along the east line of said Schmucker's land, and passing over a 5/8" rebar found at 30.00 feet, a distance of 875.00 feet to a 5/8" Capped rebar set;

thence North 90° 00' East, a distance of 250.00 feet to a 5/8" Capped rebar set;

thence South 0° 48' West, and passing over a 5/8" rebar set at 845.00 feet, a distance of 875.00 feet to a point on the centerline of said Nash Road;

thence South 90° 00' West, along said road centerline, a distance of 250.00 feet to a point and the true place of beginning and containing therein 5.0213 acres of land as surveyed in February, 1998 by Jerry W. Daniel, P.S. #6222.
